
MRC activities began on 24 December 2008 when the company handled the first ship and transshipped 2,000 tonnes of imported piles. In 2017, the terminal's throughput exceeded 5.5 million tonnes. With that annual result, Multipurpose Reloading Complex LLC won the 'Industry Leader' competition of the Federal Marine and River Transport Agency in the 'Marine Stevedoring Company' nomination and was also acknowledged as the best stevedore by the Association of Commercial Sea Ports.

Over a decade, MRC handled more than 30.6 million tonnes of cargo. The nearest plans of the company include a comprehensive development with a purpose to increase its production capacity to 8.2 million tonnes per year.
